Parents - Volunteers - 6 Hole Golf Plan Advice

- Order of teeing off is always least experienced golfer to most experienced golfer-left to right in a straight line across the fairway.... <u>At The Same Time</u>.
 <u>Note: all four students hit at once from a safe distance to save time.</u>
- Students should always put bags in a line to the right of their hitting area in their teeing off order. If on a cart please keep vehicle(s) 8-10 ft behind players.
- Students should always stand on the side that they can see the face of the person that is hitting (right side for right handed players and left side for left handed players).
- Students should stand at least 8ft away from the person that is hitting.
- Students should come prepared with balls, tees, and a ball marker before the round.
- Students should have their club and ball ready for when it is their turn to hit.
- Putting is done one at a time, least experienced to most experienced. Students get one chance each to putt... a max score of two putt. The 6-hole team format on Thursday's is a scramble. The best ball out of the group of students will be chosen and each student will hit from that spot. This process continues until the ball is in the hole or a max of 9 shots (max 2 putts).
- It is important to remind students that they must not scuff their feet on the greens around the holes. Doing so ruins the grass on the greens and makes putts for other people more difficult.
